Maldivians proudly claim that 100 percent of the population is Muslim. The real number is closer to 99.4 percent. Pray for those who worship in secret. Pray that they are able to share the gospel; with very little Bibles available it can be hard. Pray that God will open the hearts of Maldivian Muslims to be receptive to the Gospel of Jesus Christ.
